Regulations

Each crew got **six minutes** to show their skills and moves.

The **jury**, consisting of 3 people, chooses the best four crews. After this the **final battle** and the **battle for the 3rd place** take place.

After determining the winning crews, the placements from 1-4 are done. Furthermore the **best show** will be awarded.

Basic rules for all "Battle of the Year" eliminations & finals:

The basic rules for all international BOTY events should make the competition itself much more fair to all participating crews, give a guideline and support for all local organisers, help to develop the art of b-boying, dancing and performing in general and make the BOTY events more interesting to the participating crowd.

- the maximum length of the show is 6 minutes which will be very strictly adhered to
- only real crews are allowed to participate in the competition, allstar teams or joined crews are no longer tolerated. Real crews means dancing, practising and performing together beside the BOTY
- it is recommended that the maximum number of crewmembers is 8 or even less
- the individual dancers are only allowed to join one national or international elimination
- involved members of the local BOTY organisations are not allowed to participate in the competition as a dancer

Competition

- First every crew presents themselves with a show.
- Afterwards the judges determine the 4 finalist crews.
- The finals consist of 2 battles, in which the 4 best crews dance against each other for 1st and 3rd place.
- The winner is entitled to enter the international Battle Of The Year 2006 in Braunschweig.

Rules

Show Rules:

- It is recommended that the maximum number of crewmembers is 8 or even less
- The maximum length of the show is 6 minutes which will be very strictly adhered to
- The show is no compulsory exercise. Everybody can and should present what he can do best.

Battle Rules:

- The battles are carried out within the action - reaction mode.
- Substituting or adding dancers for the battles is not allowed.
- Touching or disrespecting the opponents lead to disqualification.
- Actions outside the given time will not be judged.

Judging

Since 2003 the same judging system is used at all national BOTY – eliminations and also at the international BOTY - final. Different point-criterias from 1 to 10 result in the end-rankinglist which determines the 4 crews battling for 1st and 3rd place.

Registration

Every crew which has read, accepted and adheres to the above-mentioned regulations is entitled to participate in Battle Of The Year South East Europe. Furthermore no crew and no dancer is allowed to take part in a further Battle Of The Year elimination.

As soon as the registration form arrives the headoffice we will contact the contact person and send him/her further information.

FREE ENTRY ONLY FOR PARTICIPATING DANCERS – PLEASE READ!!!

Only participating dancers which are named on the registration form get free entry. Should a dancer drop out or be absent the entrance ticket can only be passed on to a substitute dancer – otherwise the entrance ticket becomes invalid. It cannot be passed on to a non-participating person.

Each crew receives one free entrance ticket for their coach. **No additional tickets** will be handed out – to nobody!!! For all other persons the regular entrance fees are valid.

The participating crews can enter the location at 2pm! Only registered dancers and coaches are allowed to enter the ground. Fellow passengers have to wait for public entry.
